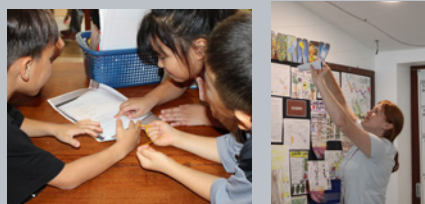
ART

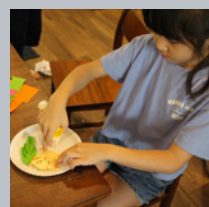
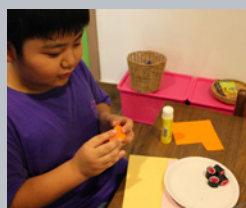
SWIMMING

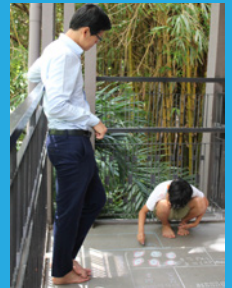

What a special day it was having our wonderful families join us for the day. The learners loved having you join in their lessons and we hope you had fun learning with us.



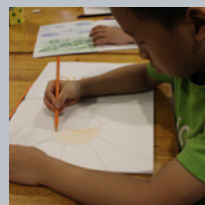
LITERACY
