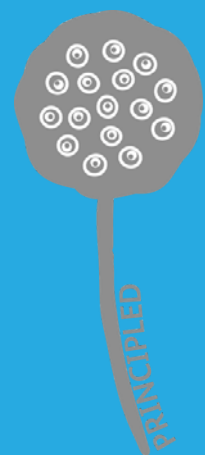

I am star of the week for being a super communicator in literacy when writing about my spaceship that got hit by an asteroid and the unusual cactus I discovered on the new planet!

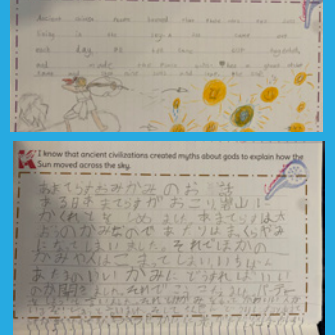
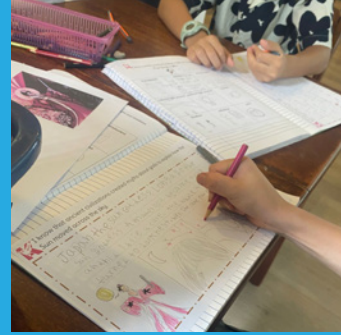

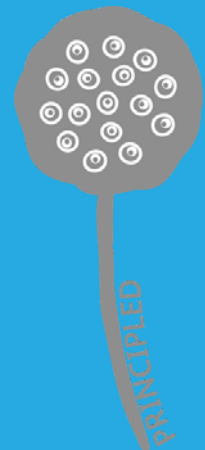
