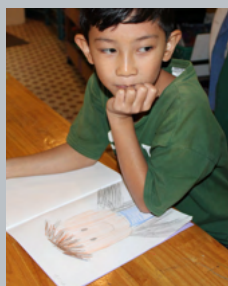
## MUSIC
