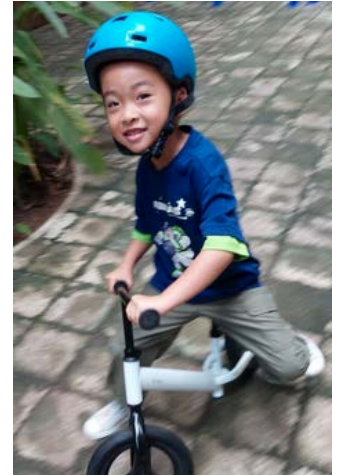

There is nothing quite like the sound of a busy, happy school, so it was with great excitement that we opened our gates on Wednesday morning to big smiles and excited faces.

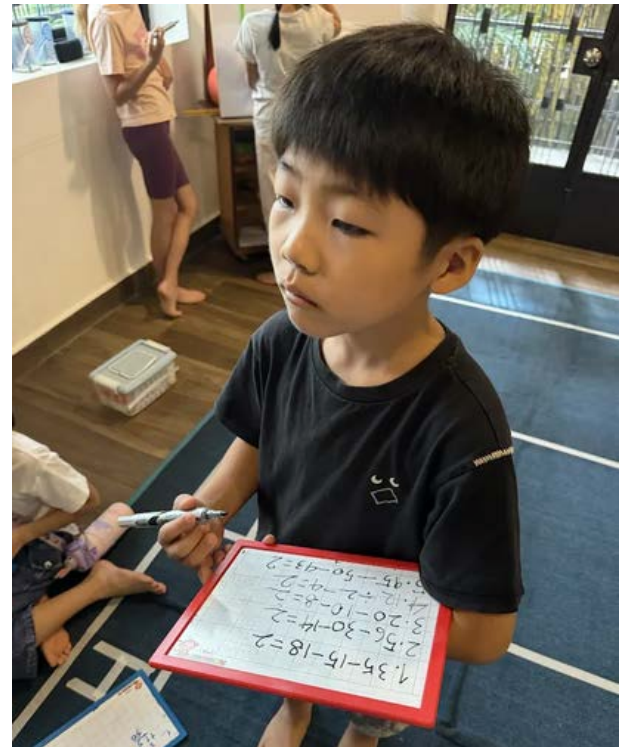

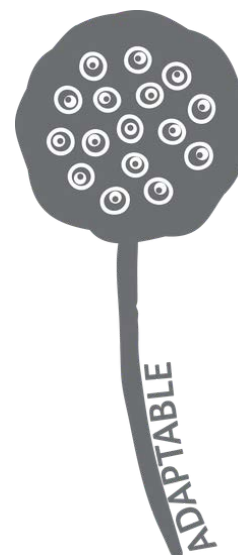
UPDATES...
