YEAR 4 - SPELLING

Year 4 start each Literacy lesson with practise of key spellings. They apply the phonics sounds that they know to spell words with a range of digraphs and trigraphs. Alongside these phonetic spellings, they learn and practise *tricky* or *red words* that are not phonetically decodable. This regular practise helps them to choose the correct sound when they are spelling independently in their writing.

There has been so much learning happening at iCP this week! The learners have been developing their imaginative play, creativity and exploration both inside and outside the classroom. They had great fun during water play and swimming with Ms. Maggie in the big pool.





YEAR 1 SWIMMING
