MP2 have been learning a number of new songs with Mr Lewis and will continue to practise these for our upcoming singing assembly.



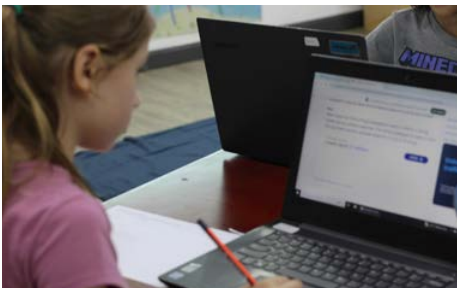
YEAR 3 RESPECTFUL CELEBRATION
